Babergh and Mid Suffolk District Councils are now starting the second stage of the Vision Programme to help more Suffolk towns realise their ambition to become key destination towns in the region.

This Vision work aligns seamlessly with our new Neighbourhood Plan. This sets out a framework to address current issues, but it has around a 15-year lifespan, so the Vision sets out where we are aiming for beyond that. By looking much further into the future, we can ensure that other decisions, strategies and actions collaborate to work alongside the Neighbourhood Plan and deliver the aspirations we set ourselves. Anyone who has already been involved in the Neighbourhood Plan will be interested in this next logical step, and anyone who has not been involved is very welcome to be part of planning their own future.

The Town and District Councils and their specialist partner, *thinkingplace* want to hear from you as stakeholders in Hadleigh whether you are a resident, community group, business, charity etc. as a key part of the Vision programme.

Building on the views collected through the Neighbourhood Plan, this 'Visioning' process will start by listening to you to understand what the Hadleigh area is about, and what makes it special. This will draw out what people love about Hadleigh, which might be heritage, community, events etc.

Once this 'sense of local place' is identified we will be able to set out how we would like others to see Hadleigh and develop an identity a 'unique selling point' to promote the town, stimulating civic pride and promoting investment.
