## Social distancing in Hadleigh

The Town Council is concerned about pedestrian safety in the High Street. To ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable visit, Suffolk County Council has developed a plan (see map overleaf) to install a **TEMPORARY** one-way measure which will allow the footpaths to be wider for pedestrian safety when the street is busy. A 20mph speed limit will be in force, and there will be some restrictions on parking, but residents' access, disabled parking, deliveries and emergency access will be available throughout the intervention. This is a temporary measure in response to an unprecedented event, so it is inevitable that it will need some fine-tuning over the coming days. We would therefore welcome your feedback on how it works.
